- Sponsored by West Carolina and National Telephone Cooperative Association's Foundation for Rural Service
- <u>Student must be a rising high school senior</u> (graduating in 2027) and must be <u>under the age of 18</u> at the time of the tour
- Student will be selected by West Carolina selection committee (all names/personal information will be removed from applications before selection committee reviews them ensuring a fair selection process).
- Student will be expected to abide by the NTCA conduct guidelines
- Legal Guardian must be a member of West Carolina.
- Student will be required to tour West Carolina's facilities before departure
- Student will be required to report to the Board of Directors on their Washington experience.
- 31<sup>st</sup> year of participation by West Carolina.
- Approximately 100 students from all over the United States will be participating
- Focus will be on the critical role telecommunications plays in rural America and the impact policy development in the nation's capital has on this industry
- Tour includes U.S. Capitol, U.S. Supreme Court, Federal Communications Commission, U.S. Department of Agriculture, Smithsonian Institute, Arlington Cemetery, Roosevelt and Lincoln Memorial, Washington Monument and several other landmarks.
- Meet with a member of Congress
- Costs paid by West Carolina Tel include: registration, air fare, meals, transportation to all activities, admission tickets to all ticketed events, T-shirt, "yearbook" and a provided \$100.00 visa gift card for checked bag and/or souvenirs. Student is responsible for any other personal spending money.
- Will be met at airport by NTCA staff and will be chaperoned at all times. There will be 1 chaperone per approximately 5 students.
